

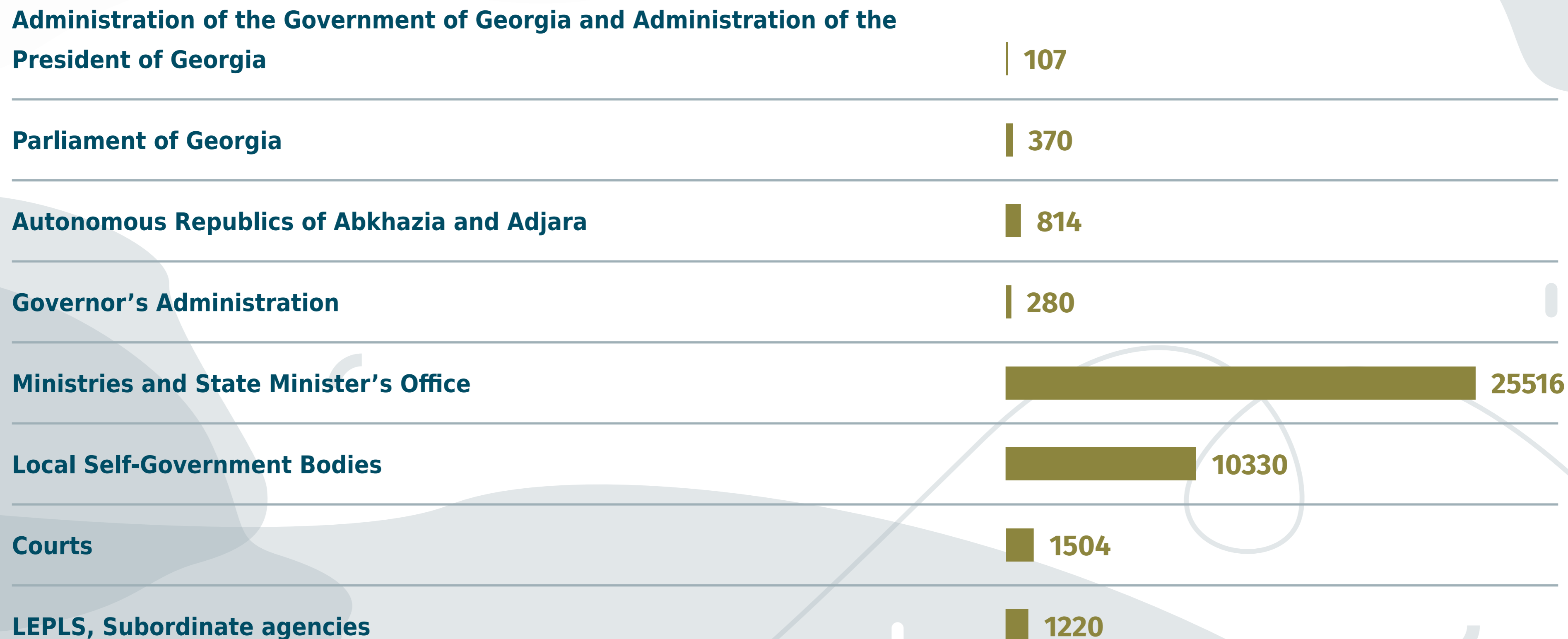

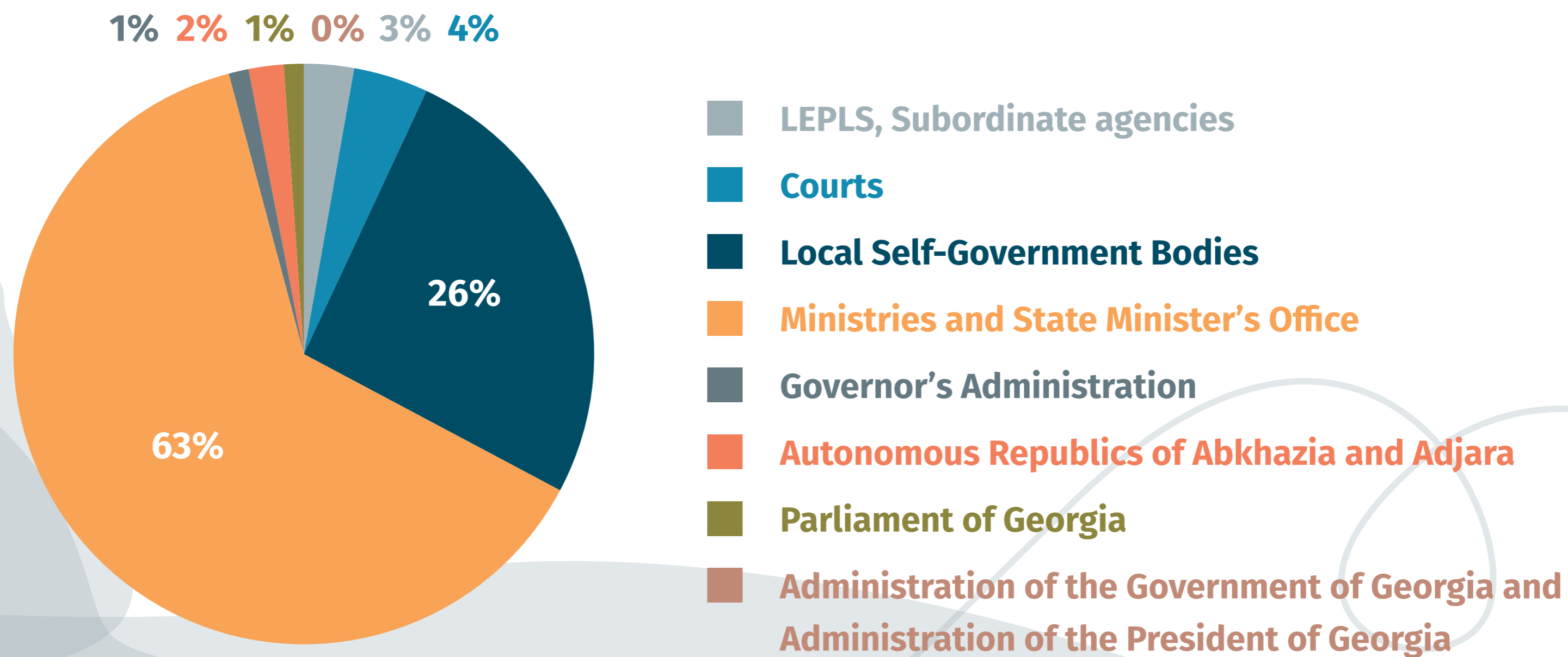

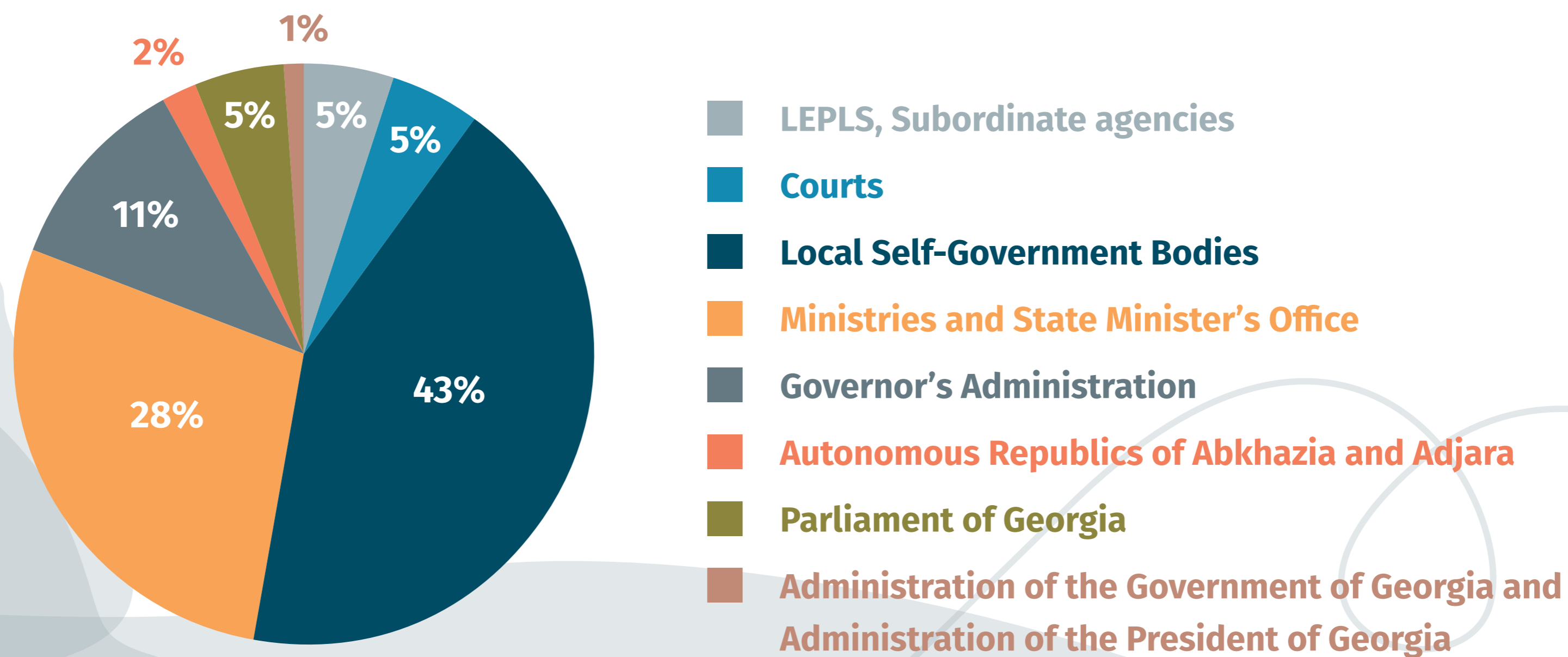

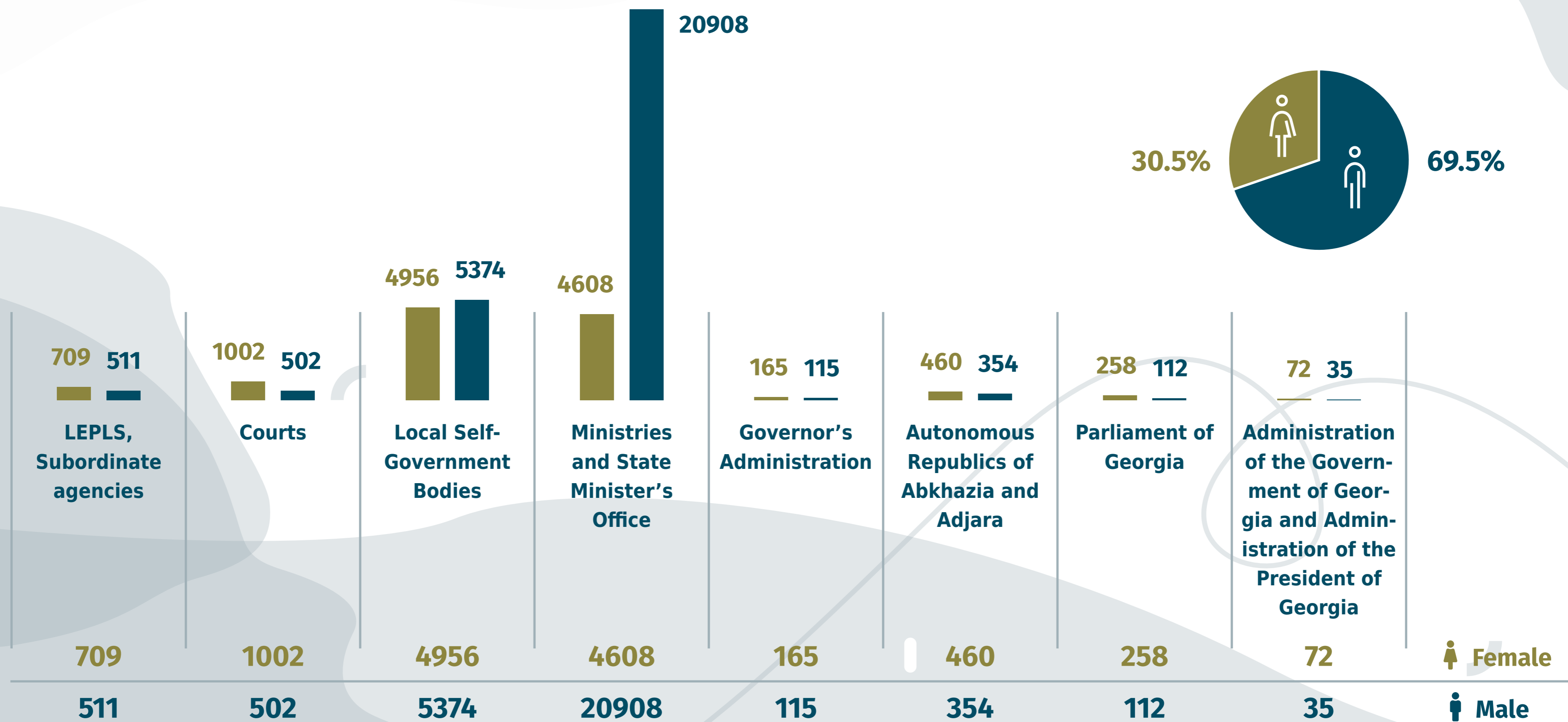

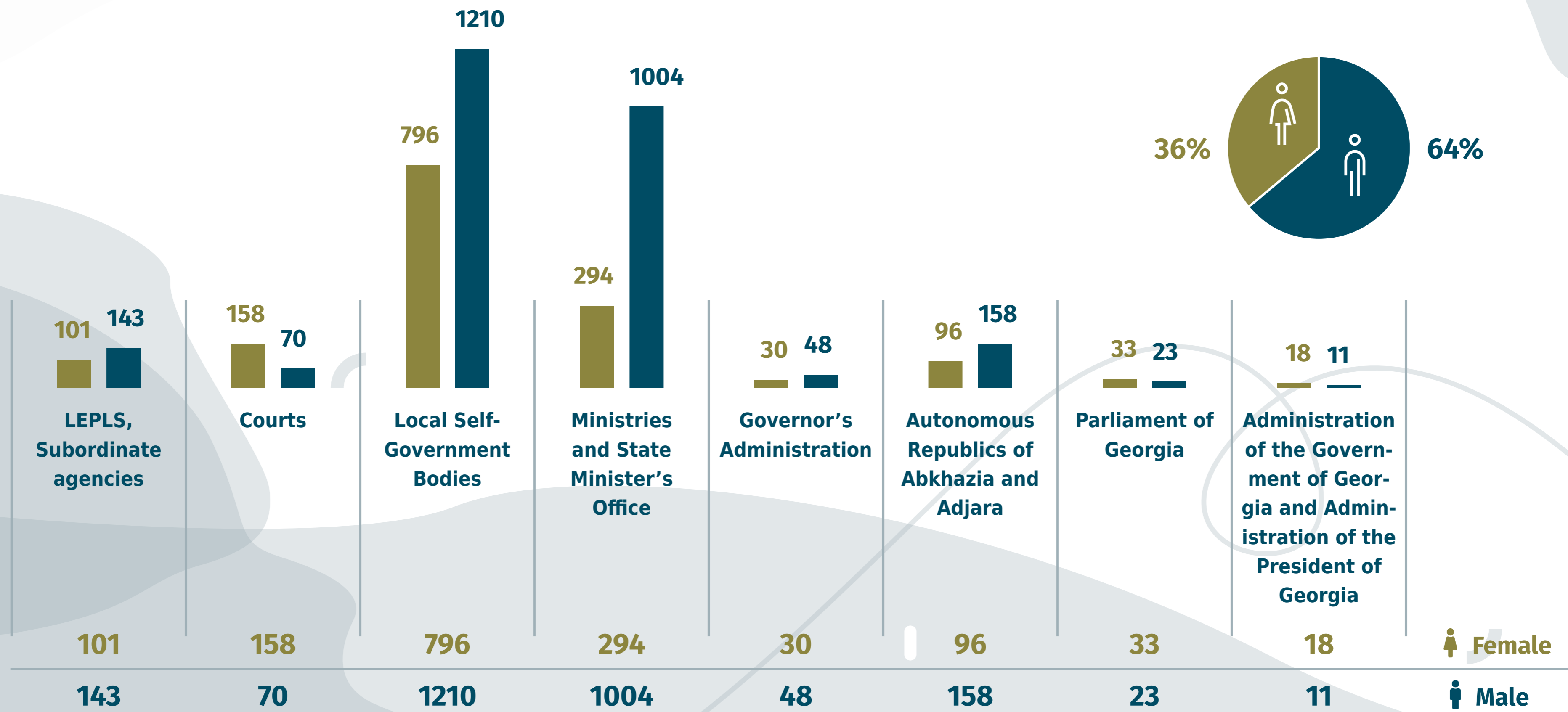
Number of professional civil servants (I and II rank)



Number of male and female professional civil servants (I, II, III and IV rank)

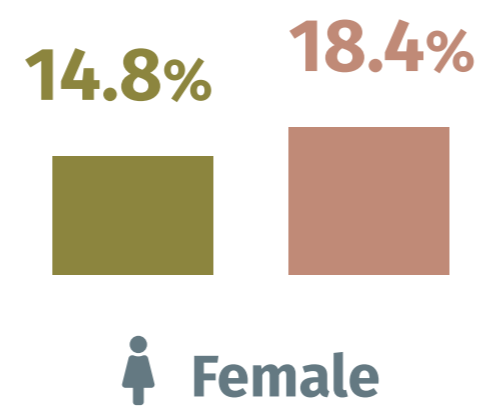


Number of male and female professional civil servants (I and II rank)

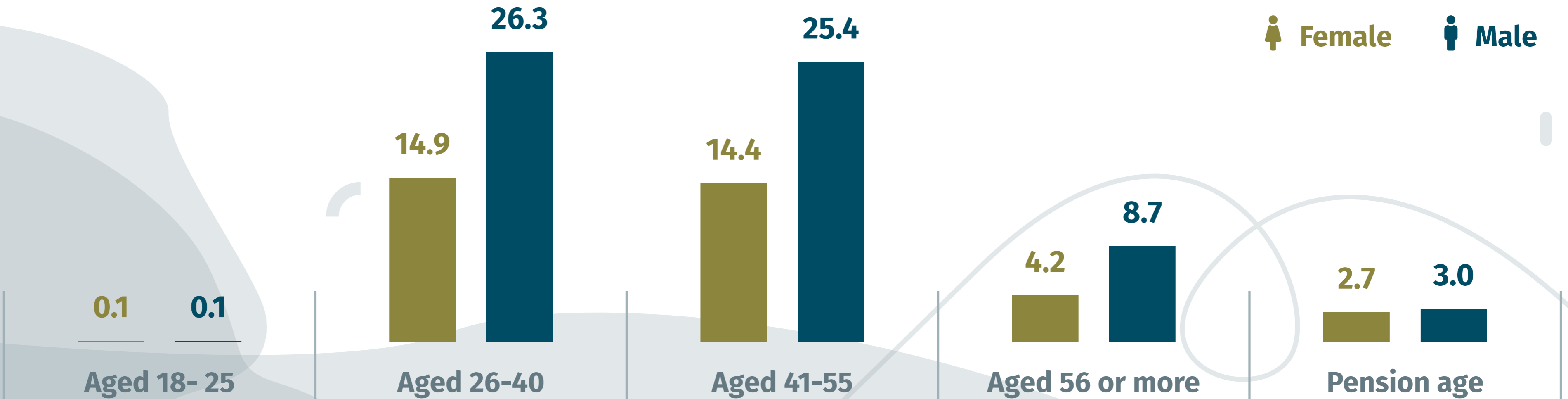


Head/Deputy of the Public Institution (%)

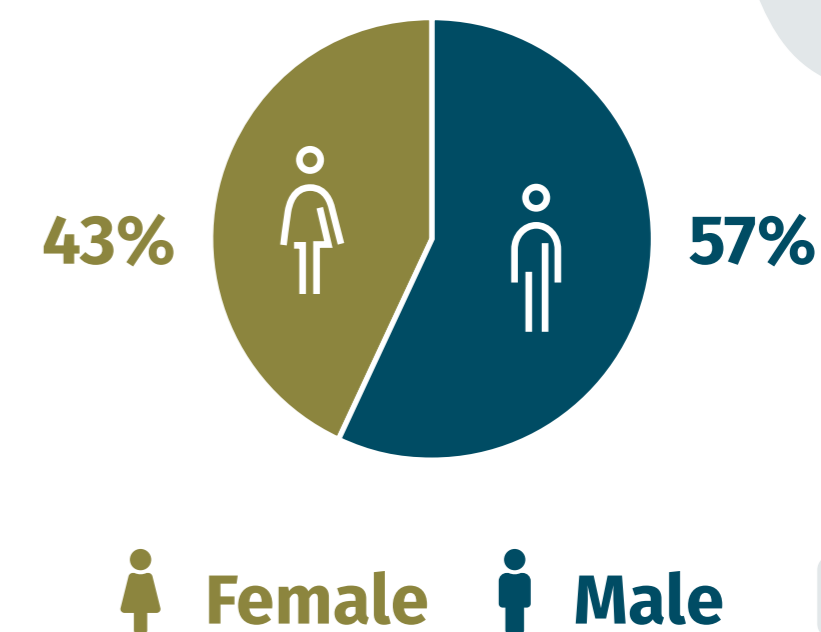

Number of male and female professional civil servants based on age group (I, II, III and IV rank)

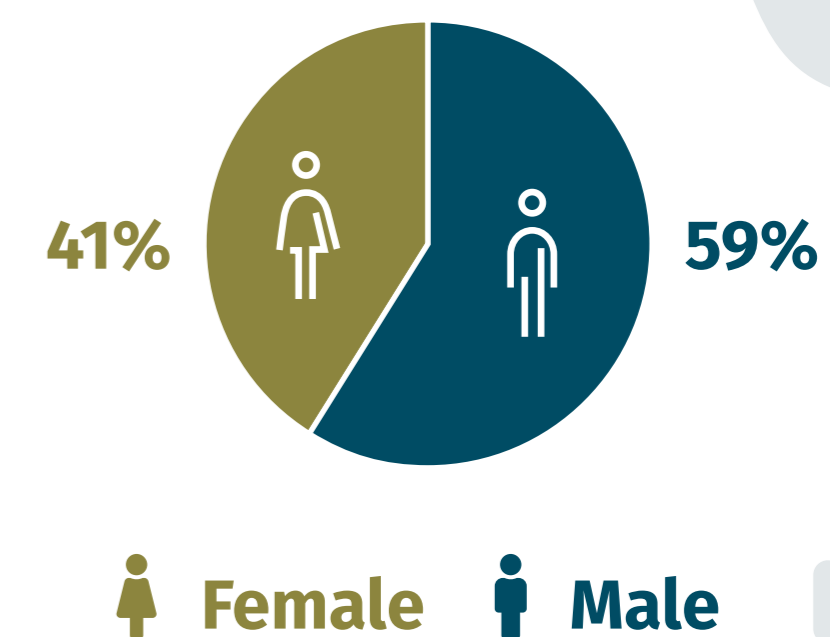


Number of professional civil servants with disabilities



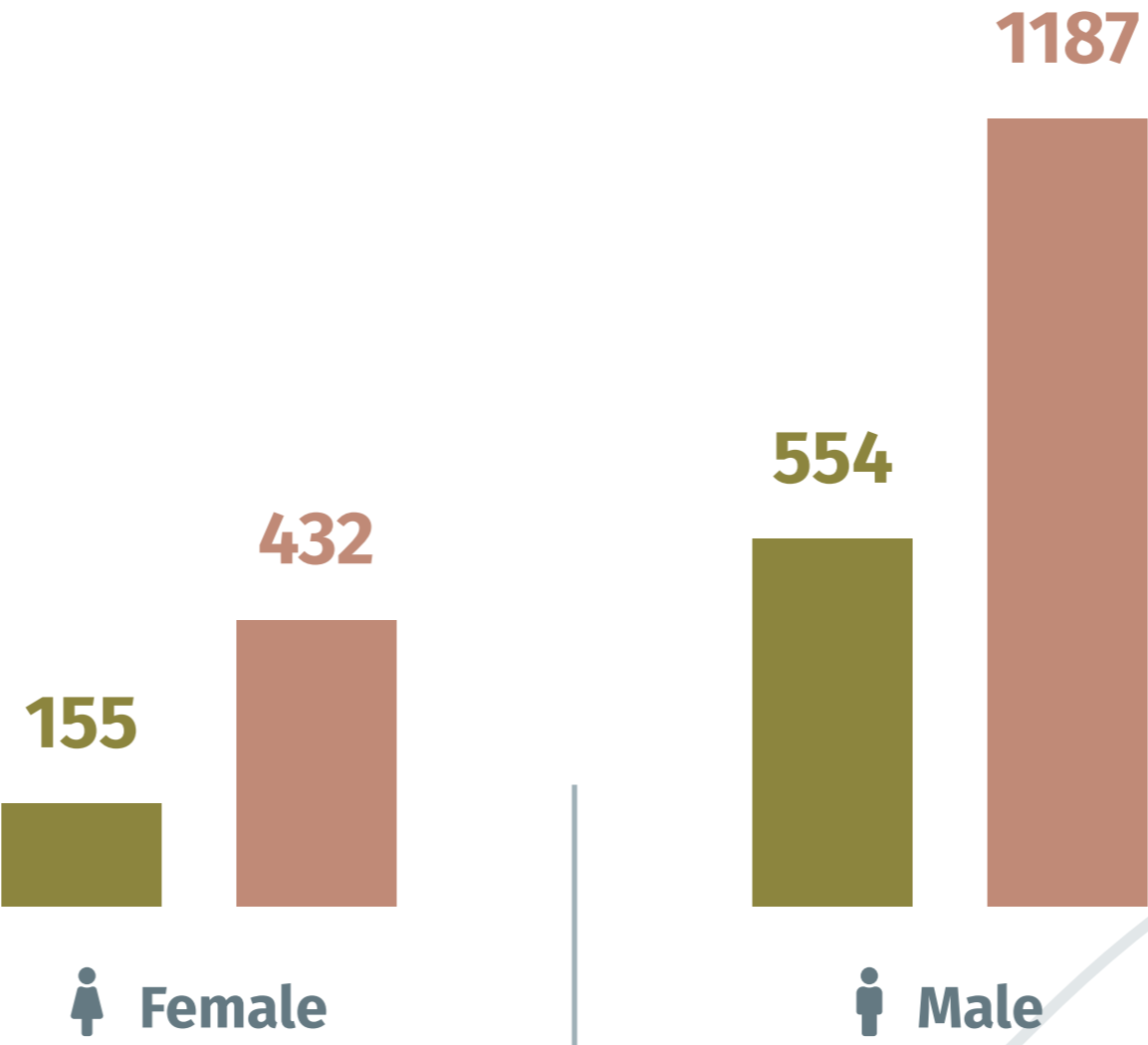
